The staff are here 30 minutes before the start and at least an hour after the last session ends. Please be on time for your session. Even a ten minute delay has a knock-on effect for the rest of the day.

A message from our chairman

Joanne and the staff always put our members first and will try to accommodate you if you need an earlier or later appointment or try to get you in at a time that will fit in with any other appointments you may have. Unfortunately, this is not always appreciated by our members.

Ideally, we need 24 hours notice of cancellation. While this is not always possible, it really is not acceptable that we are given as little as ten minutes notice.

The most popular sessions are mid-morning and we are frequently asked to let members know when a cancellation means they can attend in someone else's place. We need at least two hours to be able to do this.

Cancelling your booking at the last minute not only deprives someone else of a session, it also has financial implications for the centre.

Joanne has in the past put on an extra morning or evening sessions for one person - who then failed to turn up and didn't offer to pay.

Please show our staff the same consideration they show you.
